



# **Brandywine ES Short-Term Plan**



- For school year 24-25, Brandywine ES kindergarten students are being housed at Baden ES due to over-enrollment
- For school years 25-26 and 26-27,
   Brandywine ES kindergarten students will be assigned to Baden ES
- Students will attend Brandywine ES beginning in first grade

# Brandywine Academy New Facility






- Construction Completion/School Opening in Fall 2027




#### **ENROLLMENT**



# **Brandywine Academy Attendance Area Map**




#### **Grades 3rd-5th**


#### **Instructional Impact:**
