**Instructional Learning Formats**- The teachers use a variety of modalities including auditory, visual, and movement and use a variety of materials to effectively interest students and gain their participation during activities and lessons.and activities, and transitions were quick and efficient.

**Teacher Sensitivity**- The teachers are consistently aware of students who need extra support, assistance, or attention. Teachers are consistently effective at addressing students' problems and concerns.

**Productivity**- The teachers provide activities for the students and deal efficiently with disruptions and managerial tasks. Transitions are quick and efficient. The teachers are fully prepared for activities and lessons.

**Behavior Management**- The teachers are consistently proactive and monitor the classroom effectively to prevent problems from developing. The teachers effectively redirect misbehaviors.





**Concept Development**- Ensure concepts and activities build upon one another and support children in applying previous learning. Provide more opportunities for students to be creative and/or generate their own ideas and products. Consistently use discussions and activities that encourage analysis and reasoning to support students' problem solving development.
