Reading/Language Arts

This month, students will begin to complete analytical writing prompts with minimal assistance. Students will also explore poetry and its elements in order to apply these skills to their work.

Math

This month, students will continue to strengthen their division skills through real world application. By the end the month, we will shift our focus to decimals where students will begin to relate decimals to fractions using diagrams and sketches.

Science/Social Studies

In science, students will continue to explore the relationship between energy and collisions. We will also begin investigating various energy sources and evaluating the impact they have on our environment.
