What We Are Learning this Month:

This month students will practice the skill of jumping rope as well as being able to create and execute their own SMART Fitness Goals. In grades Prek to 2nd, students will develop basic coordination skills by learning to jump over a stationary rope while maintaining balance. They will practice fundamental movement patterns such as jumping, landing, and swinging the rope. Through guided activities, students will improve hand-eye coordination and rhythmic skills. In grades 3rd to 5th, students will enhance their jump rope skills by learning more advanced and intermediate techniques.
