School Supplies

In an effort to support our families, we have purchased school supplies and backpacks for every student. Supply pick up will take place on Friday, August 23rd during PreK/Kindergarten Orientation (9:00 am - 10:00 am) and our Open House for Grades 1 - 5 (10:30 am - 11:30 am) in the classrooms.

Students will be expected to bring their Chromebook and charger daily to and from school. Their Chromebook should be fully charged and ready to use each day.

School Hours

Our school hours are 7:30 am to 1:40 pm. Children should arrive at school between 7:20 am and 7:30 am. Children who arrive after 7:30 am will be considered late and marked as such. Breakfast will be available for student pick-up in the cafeteria from 7:20 am to 7:30 am. No child should be left at school before 7:20 am. The school does not provide supervision of children until 7:20 am.

Arrival

- Buses will arrive and drop off students at the **main entrance**
- Car riders should follow the direction of the staff and patrols on the front sidewalk
- Cones will be placed to direct car flow
- Cars should not stop and drop off students until they have pulled up into the labeled "drop off zone"
- Students should ONLY exit the vehicle on the **right hand side**
- Cars should **not** pull around to pass unless directed by a staff member
- ALL students will enter through the main entrance doors
- In order to remain healthy and safe we ask that parents drop students at the main entrance doors and "Kiss and Wave"

Dismissal

Dismissal will begin at 1:40 pm

Bus Riders and After Care Students

• Dismissed from the cafeteria through the main entrance doors



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Walkers/Car Riders

- PreK will exit through the rear classroom doors
- Kindergarten will exit through the rear classroom doors
- 1st grade students will exit through the lower level doors
- 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th grade students will be dismissed through the main entrance doors
- Parents/guardians should wait on the sidewalk in the specific area assigned to the grade-level for walker pick-up

Main Office Hours

The main office is available via telephone or by in-person appointments Monday through Friday from 7:15 am - 3:15 pm.

2024-2025 School Year Meal Prices

Elementary (Pre K through Grade 5)

- Breakfast: \$1.60/day
- Lunch: \$2.75/day

There is no cost to students who are eligible for Free or Reduced Price Meals.

To apply, you will need:

- The name, school and grade for your school-age children
- The name of all adults living in the home
- Income information for all adults living in the home
- Student ID Numbers for your school-age children

All children should bring home a **Free and Reduced Lunch Application**. We are requesting that all our families apply for the program to ensure that no one who is eligible is left out.

Instructions:

- Fill out one application per family at the following site <u>Apply for Free and Reduced Priced Meals</u>.
 Remember that is one application per family. If you need assistance completing the application, please contact Mrs.Barrientos at <u>esbarr@pgcps.org</u>.
- If you filled out and sent the application over the summer, please complete the Application Status Form and return that to your child's teacher.
- Some families will receive a Spanish and an English version of the form once school resumes, but you only need to fill out ONE of the two. If you complete a physical copy of the application, return the form to each child's teacher.
- We encourage ALL families to complete the form prior to the return of school.



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Student Lunch Accounts

- Students will receive **6-digit PIN numbers** which will remain with them until they graduate.
- Parents and guardians are encouraged to prepay for meals by depositing funds into each student's account
 via online payment at Myschoolbucks.com. Food and Nutrition Services accepts cash, certified checks,
 or money orders at the registers. Personal checks are NOT accepted.

Postcards with bus assignments will be mailed to families with students who are registered for school the week of **August 19.**
